

Welcome to VIRGINIA SUMMER DRESSAGE

Ride times will be posted on the show website on Tuesday, June 15th.

Stall assignments will be posted on the show website by Thursday evening, June 17th and posted inside the show gate by 10:00 AM on Friday, June 18th. Stall bedding (if pre-ordered) will be in stalls when you arrive. The price of extra bedding is \$9.00 per bag of shavings. Please email Dianne Boyd with orders for shavings by Wednesday pm if you want shavings in your stall when you arrive. During the show, shavings will be available for purchase in the show office. Horses may arrive on Friday morning. No check-in (at show office) or schooling before noon!

EVERYONE ATTENDING THIS COMPETITION MUST READ and COMPLY WITH the VSD COVID-19 PLAN (attached). Upon arrival: Unvaccinated people must wear a mask at all times. Vaccinated people are only required to wear a mask indoors. EVERYONE entering the show office will be REQUIRED to wear a mask.

The show office will be located in the HITS show office, to the left side of the entrance drive. Office hours: Noon-7pm Friday, 7am-6:30 pm Saturday, 7am-1 hour after show ends on Sunday. **Packets can be picked up starting at NOON on Friday.**

Chips and bottled water available at check-in on Friday compliments of Mary Phelps (Markel Insurance). On Saturday evening, join us for the Competitor's party on the café deck. We will have beverages (wine, lemonade, water) and hors d'oeuvres. The party is sponsored by Rosinburg Events. It will start around 5:30 pm - just after the end of classes on Saturday. At noon on Sunday, stop by the show office for Ice Cream, generously sponsored by Greber Dressage.

NO horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a current negative Coggins test. You must also show documentation of your horse's Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the show. All out of state horses must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) that was written and signed by an accredited veterinarian within the previous 30 days.

For those who are driving and using Mapquest, the physical address is: HITS Commonwealth Park, 13256 Commonwealth Parkway, Culpeper, VA 22701. Directions from US Rte 522/VA Rte 3 West, going towards Fredericksburg: Turn left off the ramp, in less than 1/8 mile, turn right at the light onto Rte 522 South. Commonwealth Park is about 4 miles on the left.

Day parking for Dressage entries is permitted under the trees near the entrance to the dressage rings or in the stable area. Day parking for DSHB horses is adjacent to the DSHB ring. **DSHB in-hand horses are not permitted to be exercised around the dressage performance rings at any time during the show! DSHB horses may be exercised in or around the DSHB ring. See map below.**

HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE and DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear. Handlers, assistant handlers and whip assistants of any age must wear protective headgear while handling or assisting in the competition ring.

NEW for 2021: We will use paperless scribing and scoring. Your test sheet will be sent to your email address as soon as your class is finished. Note also that you can check CURRENT ride times (during the show) via a link on the RE website. Check it out.

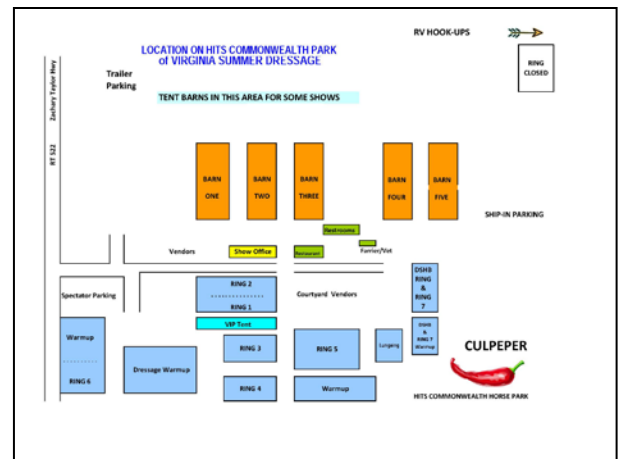
